Members elected or appointed to terms expiring in 2018 shall serve one additional year, and members elected or appointed to terms expiring in 2020 shall serve one additional year, due to a one-time extension of terms per Ordinance No. TBD¹. Beginning with election held in 2019, and each election thereafter, each and every Member shall be elected for a four (4) year term, or until a successor is elected or appointed."

Section 3: Selection of Officers -

A. Officers shall be elected bi-annually by the Board at the first meeting following an election for Members and every two years thereafter. Newly elected officers shall take office immediately upon election. Officers elected bi-annually by the Board in 2016 shall have a one-time, one-year term extension to coordinate officers' elections with the 2019 Neighborhood Council election.

Section 4: Officer Terms – Officers shall be elected for a two (2) year term and serve at the pleasure of the Board. <u>Officers elected bi-annually by the Board in 2016 shall have a one-time, one-year term extension to coordinate officers' elections with the 2019 Neighborhood Council election.</u>
