I. Meeting called to order by Chair, Candy Williams at 6:36 PM

- a. Minutes for July 2020 were approved as presented. Motion to accept minutes by Jeffrey Hartsough, seconded by, Lisa Petrus. The vote was approved (4 yes Hartsough, Petrus, Shapiro, Williams), 0 no and 1 absent Howard Katchen due to intermittent technology problem).
- II. Public official Betty Wong commented that the city would like either the treasurer or the president of SONC to submit the funding to the city clerk for review.
- IV. Treasurer's report was presented. There were no changes or comments.

#### V. THE FOLLOWING FUNDING MOTIONS WERE REVIEWED & ACTED UPON:

- b. Discussion of agenda item V. a, an expense report (MER) for period ending July 31, 2020 was reviewed. Motion to approve was brought by Howard Katchen, seconded by Lisa Petrus. Motion was approved unanimously by SONC Finance Committee members (5 yes 0 no).
- c. Discussion of agenda item V. b, reallocation of \$10,000 from fiscal year 2020 carryover funds to be classified to the NPG category for the FY 2020-2021 budget. Motion to approve Howard Katchen, seconded by Lisa Petrus. Motion was approved unanimously by SONC Finance Committee members (5 yes, 0 no).
- d. Discussion of agenda item V. c., the non-purpose grant for Los Angeles Responsible Pit Bull Owners, Inc. for \$5,000. After a discussion there was a motion to request that an amendment to the original request be reduced to \$1,000 for auto repair by Jeffrey

Hartsough, this was seconded by Lisa Petrus. Motion was approved unanimously by SONC Finance Committee members (5 yes, 0 no).

- e. Agenda item V. d., request for NPG funds in the amount of \$4,750 for the Kester Elementary food grant program was brought up for action. After lengthy discussion about the feasibility gift cards to individuals the non-purpose grant was denied for we are not permitted to give gift cards to individuals. Vote was 0 yes, 4 no (Hartsough, Petrus, Shapiro, Williams), 1 absent Howard Katchen due to intermittent technology problem.
