TRAFFIC There was discussion of the rush hour traffic problem of Van Nuys Blvd and crossing Ventura Blvd. west of Van Nuys.

PARKING VARIANCE AT 13568-75 RYE STREET There was discussion of the status of the decision of the Planning Commission regarding parking.

MTA It was noted that the MTA consent decree was not being extended.

FUTURE MEETINGS Since the 4th Wednesday in November falls on the night before Thanksgiving it was decided to have the next meeting on the 5th Wednesday in November, i.e. November 29th. Since the 4th Wednesday in December fell between Christmas and New Years it was decided not to have a meeting in December.

ANNOUNCEMENTS Pat Davenport announced that at the Sherman Oaks-Van Nuys Park there would be a dedication on Thursday November 9th and a clean up on November 11th.

CONDITION OF PROPERTY There was discussion of the messy state of property at Van Nuys and Huston. Pat Davenport referred to calling 311 to report poor condition of property.

DEDICATION OF PROPERTY Pat Davenport noted that property extended to the middle of the street, subject to dedication to the city. She also referred to restrictions on planting of property on streets without sidewalks.
