  - Officers Trent Berry & Anthony Cabunoc, LAPD discussed car/property theft (bikes popular right now), talked about Knock-Knock burglars and most active 9a-3p; announced LAPD Open House on Sept 17th in Van Nuys; Crims Stats for SONC Area 1
