



Sherman Oaks June 2020 Crime Snapshot

Total crime in the Sherman Oaks Neighborhood Council area decreased 4.8% in June 2020 compared with June 2019. Overall crime in Los Angeles fell 10.8% during the same period.

In Sherman Oaks, the total number of reported crimes in June 2020 fell to 257 from 270 in June of 2019.






Last 6 months in miscellaneous theft* in SONC per day
