Mayor has a budget of \$700,000 to support Safe Sidewalks. Carolyn asked: When driveways are widened, and trees are cut, is that allowed. Justin said there is a 2 to 1 ratio. But developers are cutting a tree then buying 2 trees, which sit in a city lot and dies. In lieu fees are betters when they pay for the value of the tree
