- 1. Meeting called to Order by Avo Babian, Chair at 6:39 pm
- 2. Quorum achieved with: Avo Babian, Carolyn Casavan, Sidonia Lax and David Levinson.
- 3. July Meeting minutes are tabled, and to be approved in Oct meeting.
- 4. Public comment on non-agenda items: Tom Capps, Treasurer, explained in detail the finances of SONC. He explained that there is \$11,000 of uncommitted funds. \$3,500 is usually set aside for Community Improvement. He also helped explain the steps to get financing, and recommended an action item for next meeting, asking for \$500 for printing.
- 5. Discussion items:
 - a. List of Potholes: Avo passed out a list of all the potholes that were given to Ron to give to the city to get fixed. About 50% were fixed. Tom Capps asked if we can get a list of what is schedule for street repair and where? He will email Nikki and Kathlin Quinn

 - e. Clean and Beautify 405 Underpass at Sep and Ventura with Encino NC: Avo has found an artist to beautify Underpass. Next step is to reach out to Encino NC to see if they are interested. Also reach out to the office of Adrin Nazarian.

 - a. Sidewalk Trees issues: Regarding the Latest CFAC meeting-David went to the meeting and they have made a list of recommendations for the Bureau of Engineers.
