- 1. Call to Order by Avo Babian, Chair at 6:32pm
- 2. Quorum achieved with: Avo Babian, Melissa Menard, Matthew Robertson.
- 3. Review and approve minutes March meeting.: Avo forgot to bring copies. Will be taken care of at the next meeting
- 4. Public comment on non-agenda items.
  - a. Jon Coghlan was concerned about Apartment buildings coming on Milbank a residential street. Also complained about needing more lanes for cars. Matthew answered that we needed more bike lanes.
- 5. Discussion Items:
  - a. Measure M: Avo went to a lecture by Paul Krekorian, to get a list of Valley projects. These included: A) Improving Orange Line, with possible Grade separation, and increase in capacity and speed, with a chance to convert to rail one day. B) Connect the Red and Orange Line to the Gold Line, in Pasadena, by following the 134 Freeway. C) The East Valley Corridor, a line up Van Nuys Blvd to San Fernando. D) Bus Rapid Transit in North Valley to CSUN. E)
    Sepulveda Pass Project: The Biggest of the Package. The ideal is a Tunnel, 60 ft wide, with toll roads and rail. It will be open to the investment world, and will be a public-private venture F) Improvements on the Metrolink. G) 20% will be local returns, for sidewalks, streets, bike lanes and the DASH.
  - b. DASH Promotion: New Ideas for naming of Bunch Crawl. Brunch Tour, Brunch Munch DASH. Details of costs sent to Finance committee.
  - c. New Bike Lane ideas: Matthew suggested reducing Hazeltine to 1 lane and have a bike lane.
