CHANDLER BLVD BICYCLE CONNECTION



The City of Los Angeles is working on safety and mobility improvements to connect the Valley on Chandler Boulevard in North Hollywood, Valley Village and Sherman Oaks.



PROJECT OVERVIEW

The Chandler Bicycle Connection is a project to improve mobility and connectivity in NoHo, Valley Village and Sherman Oaks. By upgrading the existing bicycle lane on Chandler Blvd between Leghorn Ave and Vineland Ave, this new protected bicycle/mobility lane will connect the existing Chandler and Orange Line bike paths and bridge an existing gap in the low-stress bicycle network in the San Fernando Valley. Funded by Metro, the project will improve access to transit and connect communities to local destinations, jobs, schools, businesses and recreation.

GOALS:

- Connect Valley neighborhoods with a safe, comfortable bikeway & pedestrian upgrades.
- Improve access to the NoHo Metro transit hub.
- Encourage safer speeds on Chandler Blvd.
- Expand options for commuting, recreation and access to local destinations.
