 - a. Meeting Called to Order at 8:01 pm

- 2. Administrative: Reviewed and approved minutes of Feb Meeting. Avo brought the motion to amend minutes and add one line "No Left turn on Pacheco and Stone Canyon."  - a. Michael Schneider: from street LA To Explain the "Healthy Streets LA" Ballot Initiative

Only 3% of the mobility plan has been implemented in 7yrs which means it will take 200 yrs to finish the plan.
