  - a. To Support AB 1909: And similar City Council File 22-0002-S83. Bicycle Omnibus Bill / Electric Bicycle / Vehicle Safe Bicycle Passing / Bicycle Registration / Operation Rules and Restrictions And write a CIS in support. Motion Tabled.
