Mail ballots are available by request for this election. To get yours, fill out the enclosed voter application, and mail it back in it in the postage-paid envelope provided. You can also request your ballot online by visiting <http://tiny.cc/ShermanOaksVoter>, or by scanning this QR code. The deadline for mail ballot requests is **Saturday June 3, 2023**. Postmark your ballot application by that date, or apply for your ballot online by **11:59pm Pacific**.

WHO CAN VOTE THIS YEAR?

Sherman Oaks NC members serve staggered terms, so while elections are held every 2 years, voters only vote every 4 years, when seats representing their region are up for election. This year, voting is open to **anyone aged 16+ who lives, works, studies, worships, or owns property or a business within Areas 2, 4, and 6 of the Neighborhood Council**. If you're receiving this you're within one of those areas - see which area is yours using the enclosed map.

Also eligible are those who belong to service organizations based in these areas which meet specific requirements (learn more at <http://tiny.cc/CommunityInterest>.) Voting is open to all regardless of immigration or housing status, as well as to those who are system-impacted, such as having been formerly incarcerated.

PROOF OF VOTER ELIGIBILITY REQUIRED

Voters are required to show proof of eligibility. This means showing something with your photo, name, birthdate, and address within NC boundaries, to prove you are a stakeholder. If you have a driver's license or ID card showing your local address and birthdate, that will do.

However, government ID is not required; you can use any item with your photo and name (like a store or gym membership card) along with a piece of mail addressed to you and something showing you are of voting age. APPLY FOR A VACANT SEAT

Sherman Oaks NC will have a vacant seat for the **Area 2 Business Representative** after this election. The term of service is 4 years and begins in July 2023; NC members serve their terms as volunteers.
