- 1.) Call to order by Jeff Kalban, Chair, 6:30 p.m.

- 6.) New Business: Continuing on our Community Plan Update this is the Land Use portion of the study. Jeff Kalban did an overview of all the different land use studies the Vision committee has done over the last seven years plus additional planning topics. Since the founding of Sherman Oaks was developer driven this is an opportunity for the community to study and address issues that would enhance the livability of Sherman Oaks in the next twenty years. Jeff wanted three areas to be studied and reported on. These will make up the three components for the Land Use portion we will submit for the Community Plan Update.

Several committee members discussed other areas to including in the studies: a.) the strip of land on Ventura Blvd from Fulton into Studio City, b.) the needed upkeep of Chandler land strip that is used by joggers, c.) adding a public art component into our study. The three study groups are as follows:

- 2.) Commercial, Chair, Tom Glick
- 3.) Public Realm, Chair, Maria Pavlou Kalban

Everyone in attendance joined which ever group interested them the most. At the September meeting each group will present their study. Some of the studies done previously by the committee can be incorporated into each of the individual studies if the group chooses.
